THE PETITION of the above-named petitioner alleges:

That your petitioner reside *S* at No. *502 Sixth Avenue, Belmar, State of New Jersey*  
in the Borough of Brooklyn, City of New York, and is *the Executor of Henry H. Schmeelck, the administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of the said which were of the said Catherine A. Schmeelck deceased, and*  
is of full age.

That the said deceased resided at the time of *her* death at No. *1372 East 92<sup>nd</sup> St, Brooklyn Boro* and died at *said No. 1372 East 92<sup>nd</sup> St, Brooklyn* on the *15<sup>th</sup>* day of *Dec 1888* ~~191~~.

Schmeelck, her husband, who died on Nov 10, 1913, leaving personal property in the sum of \$650 unadministered. On Dec 30, 1913 the Last Will and Testament of said Henry H. Schmeelck was probated and Letters Testamentary thereon was on Dec 30, 1913 issued to your petitioner by the Surrogate's Court of Kings County*

That all of the above-named persons are of full age and competent, ~~except~~

That there are no persons interested in this application or proceeding other than those hereinbefore mentioned.



Your Petitioner therefore pray <sup>de bonis non</sup> S for a decree awarding Letters of Administration of the Goods, Chattels and Credits which were of said deceased to him or such other person or persons having a prior right as may be entitled thereto, and that citation issue herein to all persons entitled thereto citing them to show cause why such decree should not be made.
