Deliveries of the new stock of the United States Steel Corporation have already begun. No date has been set for the organization of the company, but it will be perfected in the near future, without the aid of the new company which will be the New York Security and Trust Company and the Guaranty Trust Company. The transfer agent will be the Hudson Trust Company of Hoboken, N. J. The London cables announced yesterday that trading in the United States Steel shares had begun. The New York market was closed at 100, the office of J. P. Morgan & Co. As was stated on March 29, \$12,000,000 each of the common and preferred stocks have been placed abroad.

Western stocks had been for the interests which have secured Denver and Rio Grande and Rio Grande Western. That the buying has been done for the purpose of speculation has been evidenced by the fact that when 100 shares were offered they were neglected but that if a lot of 500 shares was offered it would be taken up quite readily. In the last few days practically no stock has been offered, and there has been none pressing for sale. It is understood that the dullness in these issues is the momentary result to efforts of people who have sold out to keep the market down for the purpose of getting the stock back at a lower price. It is from an excellent source that within the last few weeks the leading interests in the company have received offers for large blocks of stock. The selling, however, has been not desirous of selling at anything like present prices. The opinion is expressed, however, that not but a few thousand shares of the minority holdings have been picked up.
